PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

DAVID WALKER introduced our speaker, James Gold, Executive Director with CCISD Assessment & Accountability. He gave us a very interesting overview of Demographic Trends and how he comes up with the predicted enrollment numbers year to year. Mr. Gold has been with CCISD for 13 years and has over 30 years experience in statistics.

The school district gets \$5 per student from the government so enrollment numbers are very important to funding, staffing, and facilities. Textbooks and materials are also calculated based on the predicted enrollment numbers. He said he can't afford even a 5% error in calculations and then meets with the principals to go over his findings and predictions. Competition in where one gets their education has most recently come from Charter and Christian schools and other school districts. The CCISD currently has a \$16 million budget to serve some 38,000 kids.

PETE'S MARKET REPORT

PETE reported that the DOW is UP about 53 points and oil is at \$82.45. Gold was at \$1,121 an ounce and the NASDAQ was up 15.
