PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

CLEM STRUVE introduced speaker **ANNIE RAMIREZ**, who just recently returned from a year abroad as a Rotary-sponsored Ambassadorial Scholar to Scotland. Last year District 5930 sent two Ambassadorial Scholars to study abroad for one year. The intent of the program is to promote peace and world understanding, and Ambassadorial Scholars are selected for their ambassadorial

qualities. During that year Annie worked on her masters in Social Anthropology in Edinburgh, Scotland. The population of Edinburgh is normally 477,000, with tourism swelling it to 1,000,000 in August. Citing the creativity of the Scots, Annie noted that Scottish inventors and scientists are responsible for penicillin, the steam engine, telephone, TV, and Scotch whiskey. Famous Scots include William Wallace (Braveheart), Sir Arthur Conan Doyle, Robert Burns, Adam Smith, and David Hume. Annie was impressed by Edinburgh's historic buildings and beautiful scenery. Annie's host club in Edinburgh was the Rotary Club of Polmont (founded 19974, 30 members) and she made a point of visiting smaller clubs (sizes 5-55 members) as they were generally less familiar with the Ambassadorial Scholar program. She noted that Scottish Rotary clubs raise a toast to the Queen, and to Rotary! Annie and the other Ambassadorial Scholars in Scotland undertook a joint charitable project; together they raised over \$16,000 for Maggie's Cancer Care Centre. Annie's future plans include pursuing a PhD and to becoming a Rotarian.
