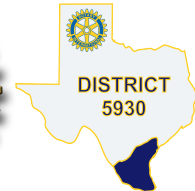

Jeremy Barnes is an Eagle Scout, Howard Payne University graduate, graduate of the Leadership Corpus Christi class of 2010, and is a Kiwanian. Mr. Barnes spoke on the topic of the history of Rotary's commitment to the Boy Scouts of America (BSA) and presented our club with a charter for Cub Scout Pack 69.

Mr. Barnes said that the BSA celebrated their 100th year on February 8, 2010. In 1910, Rotary urged Rotarians to assist the BSA. Currently, 1,483 scout units and 45,528 youth are being assisted by Rotary.

The values of the BSA oath and Rotary 4-way test are similar. They both promise to help others at all times. Many of Southside Corpus Christi's Rotary Club members were scouts. Others were parents of scouts, den mothers, or pack leaders.

Mr. Barnes also updated our club on the renovations occurring at Camp Karankawa and the scouts' recent trip to the National Jamboree in Philadelphia.

David Walker presented Mr. Barnes with a check from Southside Corpus Christi Rotary, and Mr. Barnes thanked Rotary for their continued support of BSA and Cub Scout Pack 69.
