PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

BRUCE HAMENDE introduced our speaker, John Beauregard. John is with the Boy Scouts of America and he is in charge of the Corpus Christi area. He comes to us by way of Louisiana and Mississippi. John is a member of the Corpus Christi **ROTARY** Club and a graduate of Texas Tech. John spoke to our club about 15 months ago and appreciated being allowed to speak again.

John informed us that the Boy Scouts have more tents than everyone except the U.S. Army, and that

the Boy Scouts have more boats than everyone except the U.S. Navy. The Boy Scouts build toy race cars and race them in the Pine Wood Derby Races. The children are taught first aid, how to care for the environment, and camping. The mission of Scouting is to instill core values and to help prepare the children for life as adults. Leadership is provided for the Scouts, and they are taught how to make good decisions and be successful in life.

The Boy Scouts received a \$2,500,000.00 grant from American Airlines to perform a survey. The survey determined that 98% of Scouts graduate from high school. However, only 84% of Scouts graduate from Corpus Christi high schools. Children are lured into Scouting using camping and fun things in the grade schools.

Camp Karankawa (www.campkarankawa.com) on Lake Corpus Christi is undergoing a renovation and improvement project. One part of the project is to replace the toilet type facilities with modern indoor flush toilets. The camp was built in the 1940's and is in need of several improvements. Showers and updated cooking facilities will be added as funds become available. A water slide and facilities to allow swimming fun activities will also be added.

Girls are involved in the Boy Scouts and at the present there is only one Lady Scout Master. However, there are many Lady Cub Scout leaders.

PRESIDENT LARI presented Mr. Beauregard with a pen for his presentation.
