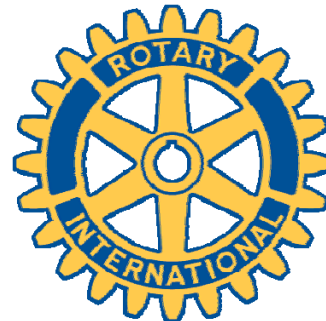

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

PDG MARILYN SPENCER introduced our speaker, Tim Fitzpatrick who is the Athletic Director at Texas A&M – Corpus Christi. Tim comes to Corpus Christi from Indiana University, and he worked at the U.S. Military Academy, the University of Pittsburg, the University of North Texas, and was an assistant commissioner of the old Southwest Conference.

Tim has been at Texas A&M – Corpus Christi for nine months and stated that Corpus Christi is a great city and a great sports town. Kids coming to Corpus Christi like the beach, the campus, and the climate. He has the support of the A&M – Corpus Christi administration and the support of the community.

He feels that it is a privilege to be able to help kids and help guide their lives. This program is to provide the student athletes with guidance, help with grades, help with finances, and help them make new friends. He wants to have a winning program in all parts of the athletic department.

He feels that the Division I athletics are the best of the best. A&M – Corpus Christi tries to provide the best education possible. Eighty one of the athletes at A&M – Corpus Christi have a GPA of 3.0 and better.

Tim is looking for more support for the program and hopes to increase attendance at all of the games and to have more support from the business community. He hopes to make the American Bank Center more accessible for the public and increase the attendance of the games. He does not think that a football program will be implemented at the university for several years to come.

Tim was presented a tax shelter for his presentation.
