PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

DAVID WALKER introduced speaker **GILBERT VANSOI**. Gilbert's mother was from Vietnam and his father was from New Caledonia. Gilbert is with Allstate Insurance, and also a Big Brother in the Big Brothers-Big Sisters program.

Gilbert is Regional Director of the South Texas Area for the AYUSA Global Youth Exchange Program. He seeks families willing to accept a high school student into their home for a year under that program. AYUSA is similar in many respects to the **ROTARY** Youth Exchange Program. That latter program requires that \$2,500.00 be paid to participate, and the AYUSA Program does not require a fee.

To qualify and host an AYUSA student, one must be at least 25 years old. Single parents and couples without children qualify. Hosts must treat the student as part of their family and include the student in family activities. It is acceptable to travel with the student. There are two types of families, arrival families (who accept the student for at least 6 weeks) and host families (who take the student for one year). As an incentive, the program will provide school systems \$500 for accepting two students.

Gilbert usually meets the students in New York City when they arrive in the United States. He provides tours of the City, and he and the students have traveled to other states and cities.

Gilbert compared the program to the **FOUR WAY TEST** and the AYUSA passes the **FOUR WAY TEST**.

PETE'S MARKET REPORT
