## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

**DAVID WALKER** introduced Bob Jones, a Christian minister and former **ROTARIAN**. Bob has worn many hats - he previously ran for the Corpus Christi City Council (and lost). He has traveled to many parts of the world, including Europe and Africa, partially courtesy of the U.S. Military. Bob currently hosts a radio program for KCTA, which broadcasts throughout Texas and into Louisiana. Bob said he gets paid to talk and 15 minutes is long enough for a good speaker.

Bob stated something is happening in our country and the happening is not good. He feels that our country is at a crossroad and has serious needs. He feels that the due process law to take private property is not being followed. He feels that our country is not adhering to the ideals and principals of our founding fathers. Thomas Jefferson stated that Democracy will kill itself and Democracy will end when voters learn to tax others for income and not to do the work themselves. George Washington stressed that his officers and troops attend "Divine Services." He urged his troops to act as Christians, but told them to take their guns with them when they attended church in case they had to leave quickly to fight. The founding fathers felt that guns were necessary to protect the people from the government. Bob feels that one cannot separate government, business, and the church in our country. He stated that we must have morality or that our political leaders will be ruthless and will tell lies.
