PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Anita Spreen introduced the presenter- Kathy Rios who is the youth minister at Grace United Methodist Church. Ms. Rios was one of the founding members of the Sea City Work Camp and now is a board member as well as a Camp Director. Ms. Rios spoke about Sea City Work Camp and the achievements it has accomplished. The organization now has 2 paid employees, a Board of Directors (50% of which are teenagers) and many volunteers. Presently they hold two one week camps per summer with 100 youth and 40 to 50 adult volunteers. The teens pay \$150 to come to camp and they repair and improve 10 to 12 houses. The camp hopes to have 3 camp sessions next year. The website is www.seacityworkcamp.com. This is a great program for the youth. They learn, work and worship while helping needy people in the coastal bend.
